

COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT

GAME RULES

HELL KART & EVENT CENTER Periodic Programs

The AVALON PARK Ltd. (1062 Budapest, Andrássy út 126.) – hereinafter referred to as the ORGANIZER – is organizing go-kart races at the HELL KART & Event Center for the year 2025. The aim of the competition is to promote and popularize cultured and fair go-kart racing among amateur and mass-sport participants.

The competition rules are based on the principles of "fair play." They provide guidance for achieving regulated and equal competition conditions for all participants. Any issues not explicitly addressed in the rules will be decided by the ORGANIZERS. The ORGANIZERS reject any attempts to misinterpret the rules in a way that prevents fair competition.

Go-Karts

Participants in the competition will race with uniform technical equipment, specifically the RIMO SiNUS iON go-karts provided by the ORGANIZERS.

Competitions

The competitions will take place at the HELL KART & Event Center track, located in Avalon Park, Miskolctapolca (3519, Miskolctapolca, Iglói út 15.). Participants who have registered in advance or on-site may compete in the predetermined time slots.

Registration

Any natural person who has reached the age of 14 may register for the competition, except for the ORGANIZER's employees and their close relatives. The ORGANIZER reserves the right to change the competition dates due to weather conditions and will inform participants within a reasonable time.

Entry Fee

Only those who have successfully registered (see: Registration) can participate in the competition. The entry fee corresponds to the current go-kart race fee, which must be paid on-site (HELL KART & Event Center) via card or cash.

Cancellation

If the competition is canceled due to the ORGANIZER's fault, 100% of the entry fee will be refunded to the participants.

Judging

The competition will be held without professional race judges. Participants must comply with the track's current house rules, which are supervised by the HELL Kart & Event Center track team (hereinafter: race supervisors). Given the nature of the competition, the decisions of the race supervisors are final and cannot be appealed.

Participants

Individuals under the age of 14, employees of the ORGANIZER, and their relatives as defined in the Hungarian Civil Code (PTK. 8:1. § (1) 1. and 2. points) are not allowed to participate in the competition. Participation requires registration at the HELL KART & Event Center.

Categories

Individual races will be conducted regardless of body weight.

Execution

Competitions will be conducted on the previously announced dates. The exact schedule depends on the final number of participants.

The go-karts will be set to uniform configurations. The maximum weight limit for participants is 120 kg.

Awards

The extent of awards for the competition will be defined in the competition announcement.

GO-KART RACE – RULES

1. Participation Conditions:

1.1. Each participant competes at their own risk and may not file any claims or demands against the ORGANIZER.

1.2. Participants are financially responsible for any intentional damage or violations of the rules.

1.3. Participants must be aware of and comply with the rules outlined in this document.

1.4. Helmets are mandatory during races.

2. Additional Provisions:

Race supervisors may establish additional provisions regarding race conditions (e.g., exclusion due to unfair racing behavior, etc.).

Track Behavior:

Participants must understand and follow flag signals:

- **Blue Flag (Static):** A faster go-kart is approaching; prepare to allow overtaking. If the kart is directly behind you, let it pass immediately.
- **Blue Flag (Waved):** A faster kart is behind you; allow it to pass at the next possible opportunity.
- **Yellow Flag:** Danger on the track; prepare to maneuver around obstacles. Overtaking is prohibited except when avoiding a stalled kart.
- **Black Flag + Kart Number:** Disqualification.
- **Checkered Flag (Waved):** End of the race.

Blue Flag Rule:

During a race, position gains are prohibited under a blue flag. This applies to both the overtaking and overtaken drivers. The overtaking maneuver must be completed before resuming normal race pace.

Basic Concepts:

- **Collision:** Occurs when two karts touch, resulting in a change in momentum or direction.
- **Pushing:** When an attacking kart maintains contact with a defending kart, altering its speed or direction.
- **Blocking:** Attempting to change another kart's direction without contact. If contact occurs, it is considered forcing off track.
- **Forcing Off Track:** Continuous contact and exerting force on another kart to change its direction.

Rules for Overtaking and Defending:

- Defenders must anticipate overtaking maneuvers and leave space when necessary.
- Position blocking by repeated direction changes is not allowed.
- Attackers must not push or force other karts off the track.
- Gaining a position by leaving the track is prohibited.

Track Definition:

The track includes the asphalt strip and curbs. A kart is considered off-track if all wheels leave the track surface.

Conduct in the Pit Lane:

- Speed must be significantly reduced upon entering the pit lane.
- Exiting the pit must be done with caution, yielding to oncoming karts on the track.

General Conduct During the Race:

- Any attempt to resolve disputes physically will result in a warning, disqualification, or permanent ban.
- Participants are prohibited from consuming alcohol before or during the race. Those found intoxicated will not be allowed to race for the rest of the day, and the entry fee will not be refunded.
